### Main highlights

- Index case is from Kailahun district
- Seven (7) laboratory confirmed cases are from Kailahun districts
- The 23 suspected cases reported are from two chiefdom (Kissi teng and Kissi Tongay) in Kailahun district
- Samples collected from the three (3) suspected cases from Kailahun, Kono and Western area.

### Action taken

- Medical tents repositioned at Kenema Government Hospital, Kailahun and Koindu
- Discussions commenced with Parliamentarians and communities in Kailahun to allow medical team to get access to patients and their contacts
- The Directorate of DPC has dispatched national surveillance officers with additional logistics to support Kenema and Kailahun districts in their surveillance activities.

There is **no travel** restriction to any district or neighbouring countries of Guinea and Liberia
