Main highlights

- For the 8th June 2014, a total of 5 suspected cases were reported: Kono (2), Kambia (1), Tonkolili (1), and Western Area Urban (1).No new confirm case
- The cumulative number of cases tested is 113, with still 42 confirmed, 40 from Kailahun and 2 Kambia districts.
- > Twelve deaths (All from Kailahun) have been reported with Fatality Rate (CFR) based on confirmed cases is 21.4%: **9 confirmed** and **3 probable**.
- > Deaths include two from the community.

Action taken

- The outreach surveillance team still in the field conducting active case search
- Sensitization of the communities including the traditional healers is currently on going.

There is no travel restriction to any district or neighbouring countries of Guinea and Liberia
