Main highlights

- A total of **36 suspected** cases have been reported with **14 confirmed** cases all from **Kailahun districts**.
- Seven (7) new Ebola Laboratory confirmed case from Kailahun districts.
- All suspected cases from Bo, Koinadugu, Western area urban are **negative**
- Medical tents prepositioned at Kenema Government Hospital and training of staff completed

Action taken

- Discussions commenced with Parliamentarians and communities in Kailahun to allow medical team to get access to patients and their contacts
- Outreach medical team now at Koindu , in Kailahun District searching for the missing confirmed cases in the community and conducting contact tracing
- Ministry of Health officials and MSF are also in Koindu setting up the isolation unit
- Training of medical staff for the isolation unit in Koindu and Kailahun commenced today

There is **no travel** restriction to any district or neighbouring countries of Guinea and Liberia
