Ebola Update 21 June, 2014

- 271 Cases have been tested, with 139 confirmed for Ebola and 33 confirmed Ebola deaths
- 44 Confirmed cases are currently admitted at the Ebola treatment center in Kenema Government Hospital
- 13 cases have so far survived the disease since the outbreak and have all been discharged from the Ebola Treatment Center in Kenema
- The Health Ministers of the Mano River Union (MRU) countries (Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone and Cote D'Ivoire) met in Conakry, Guinea yesterday 20th June, 2014 and signed a declaration to increase the collaboration and coordination among member countries in the fight against the Ebola Viral Disease (EVD)
- The Health Ministry of Guinea donated some Personal Protective Equipment, Hand Sanitizers and Chlorine to Sierra Leone as a sign of commitment to work collaboratively with Sierra Leone in the fight against the outbreak in the two countries.
