

Ebola Update...June 28, 2014

- For the 27th June 2014, a total of 24 samples were received by the Laboratory: Kailahun(15),Kenema (8) and Western Area (1)
- Among the 24 samples received by the Laboratory, 7 were confirmed positive for Ebola Virus. Kenema (1) and Kailahun (6), while 8 samples were negative cases. The remaining 9 Laboratory results are pending
- The 3 Laboratory pending results yesterday are now negative
- The cumulative number of Laboratory confirmed cases tested is 371, with 188 cumulative confirmed cases and cumulative death of 56
- Forty-one(41) cases are currently admitted at the Kenema Government Hospital, bringing the cumulative number of admissions to 124
- 4 additional cases were discharged from the treatment Center in Kenema today, bringing the cumulative discharged cases to 22
- Line listing of contacts and monitoring of case contacts have started in districts with confirmed cases
- The Minister of Health and Sanitation, the Chief Medical Officer and other members of the Top Management Team of the Minister visited Kailahun and Kenema Districts today with the WHO Country Representative in Sierra Leone to assess the Ebola Response activities in the two district
- The Government of Sierra Leone in collaboration with WFP has supplied food items to affected communities in the Kailahun and Kenema district, the food supplies will continue for the next three months
- More Personal Protective Equipment were also supplied to Kailahun and Kenema today
- A truck load of used clothing has also left for Kailahun District to assist affect individual with clothing
